Meagan's Story

In December 2001, Meagan Bebenek was diagnosed with a malignant and inoperable brain tumour. She died six months later, a few weeks after her fifth birthday.

Meagan's mother, Denise, was determined to make a difference for other children with brain tumours. With the help of family and friends, planning began for the first Meagan's Walk in 2002. At this inaugural event, 800 participants walked from Ontario Place to SickKids where they joined hands in a "circle of hope" around the Hospital. This hug showed all within that they were not alone.

More than 20 years later, the Meagan Bebenek Foundation has raised nearly \$6.1 million for paediatric brain tumour research. In 2005, the Bebeneks established the Meagan's HUG: Creating A Circle of Hope endowment at SickKids. Now valued at \$3 million, the endowment has granted close to \$800,000 and has been a driving force behind several major brain tumour discoveries.

Meagan's legacy is one of hope for children and their families, helping SickKids improve care and treatment for kids across Canada and throughout the world.

YOUR IMPACT

When you create an endowment fund, you leave a legacy that will impact children's health for generations to come. The capital from your endowment fund will be invested, with returns used to support people, places, and programs at SickKids year after year. Since inception, SickKids Foundation endowment funds have achieved an impressive rate of return of 9.2 per cent on average, and in fiscal 2023-2024, \$40.5 million in funding was generated from endowments.

Endowment fund benefits include:

- An opportunity to honour or memorialize yourself or a loved one in perpetuity by naming the fund;
- A charitable tax receipt; and
- An annual Endowment Report.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITY
